If your garden is small or you don't have a garden, renting an allotment gives you a plot of land to grow your own fruit, vegetables and flowers.

Benefits of having an allotment

The benefits of having an allotment include:

- it's an affordable source of fresh fruit and vegetables
- it reduces your exposure to pesticides
- it gives you fresh air and healthy exercise
- it helps reduce stress and can give you a sense of achievement
- it's good for the environment, providing green spaces and wildlife habitats

You can rent an allotment to grow your own fruit and vegetables.

Getting an allotment

Contact New Romney Town Council to find out if there are any vacant allotment garden plots and to request further information and an application form.

If there are currently no vacant allotment plots you may request that your name be added to the waiting list and a member of Town Council staff will contact you as soon as a plot becomes available.
