Precept 2018-19

NEW ROMNEY TOWN COUNCIL has set its Precept for 2018-19 at £309,507.00 which, in real terms, equates to a small increase on the average Band D Council Tax Bill of £2.64 per month.

This small monthly increase equals less than the average cost of a cup of coffee and, being a pro-active Council, this increase is vital to sustain its current high quality service provision.
