COMMONWEALTH DAY 2015



New Romney Town Council will be celebrating Commonwealth Day for the first time this year, holding a Flag-Raising Ceremony on the Flagstaff Land, Littlestone Road, Littlestone on Monday 9 March 2015 – an event which is, henceforth, to be an annual Civic event.

Timings and details are yet to be finalised but the Ceremony is likely to include an address by the Town Mayor, a reading and prayer by the Mayor's Chaplain and an element of participation by pupils from the Marsh Academy as well as singing of the Commonwealth Anthem, reading of the Commonwealth Affirmation and raising of the Commonwealth Flag. Members of the public will, of course, be very welcome to attend. Full details will be puclished on the Town Council website once finalised.

A free evening concert is to be performed by the City of Canterbury Brass Band in St Nicholas Church to conclude the celebrations, details of which will be advertised nearer the time, so look out for posters with information about where to get your tickets!

The recent consultation period has now concluded and information from the large number of completed questionnaires that were placed in the 'drop boxes' around the Town and received from residential and academic establishments in the Town has been analysed. This has provided the Town Council with very valuable information with which to support its funding application for a new outdoor gym, which has now been drafted and is ready for submission, so thank-you to all who took the time to complete the questionnaires.

If the application for grant funding from the National Lottery Awards For All Fund is successful, the Council will be able to begin the process of seeking designs and quotations for this exciting project, so look out for further updates in due course.



COMMUNITY HALL/SPORTS PAVILION UPDATE



As previously reported, the Town Council has commenced the consultation process which will inform the funding and design processes in this major and very exciting capital project. The Town Council recently held the first meeting of the Community Hall/Sports Pavilion Stakeholder Consultation Group and is pleased to report that it was a very worthwhile and productive meeting.

From opinions voiced at that meeting, a questionnaire is currently being drafted in order to seek the views of the wider public. Responses to this questionnaire will be extremely important in providing evidence to support funding applications for the large sums of money that will be required to bring this project to fruition and in informing the design process later down the road.
