ROLFE LANE, NEW ROMNEY

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow gas mains reinforcement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rolfe Lane, New Romney.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 7 January 2019 for an estimated period of up to 8 weeks.

Rolfe Lane will be closed in sections from the junction with Walner Lane working towards Cockreed Lane, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Local access to the remainder of Rolfe Lane continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Walner Lane, Fairfield Road, St Mary's Road and Cockreed Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

Access for any residents affected will be maintained when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
